Sun 18 May Kings Day 3: 900m & 900m x 10 shots

BLOW OFF SHOOTS

Blow off shots will be allowed every day of the NQRA Wilson and Kings at the 200m range. PROCEDURE TO FOLLOW:

Muster at 7.45am - Rifles on the concrete benches at 8am - Rifles cleared off the benches at 8.15am

Shooters to move to that day distance on the main range for starting of the daily event at 8.30 am.
